We recognise that the transition back to full time schooling comes with challenges for us all. We have worked hard to ensure children can access school safely and we appreciate your support as we have worked to improve systems this week. Thank you for your understanding, patience and feedback.

The children have adapted well to their new year groups, new classrooms and new teachers.
