Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you have adjusted to the new context of home learning across the past two weeks and you are finding the home learning packs, online learning platforms and the website useful. Thank you for the continued support you are providing to your children across this period of time. If you have yet to pick up the home learning pack, please do so from the school office as this will offer core support in the delivery of home education.

Our school office is open each day and able to deal with enquiries relating to home learning and technology. Teachers will be making regular phone calls to you to check in as part of our support package to families during term time weeks. Please do make the time to speak to teachers as it is an opportunity to ask questions and for school staff to know how you and their pupils are.
