All pupils are encouraged to take an active and creative part in lessons through memory games, songs, pair, group and team work. The children develop language skills by discussing similarities and differences and making links with other languages they already know.

Recalling verbs and structures will be important in order to write about our school in longer sentences or paragraphs.


