

At **Key Stage 1** pupils will be responding to the language and speaking with support.

In **Key Stage 2** pupils will also be taking part in questions and answers, role-playing, reading and writing words in Spanish.

All pupils are encouraged to take an active and creative part in lessons through memory games, songs, pair, group and team work. The children develop language skills by discussing similarities and, differences and making links with other languages they already know.

Why not encourage your child to teach you some of the words, phrases and songs he or she already knows?

Year 5& 6:

We will include our art and literacy skills in Spanish lessons in order to describe paintings by the Spanish painter Joaquín Sorolla.

We will be using verbs in the 3rd person, adjectives and prepositions to give greater depth to our descriptions.

Year 4

Year 4 : This half term we will learn to name different sports and think about which sports we prefer in a class survey.

Our challenge this half term will be to write independently in paragraphs (mostly from memory) using the correct part of the verb



Year 3

Year 3: We will use the months, the days of the week and use our numbers 1 – 31 with confidence so that we can say the date and birthdays in Spanish. Our challenge will be to ask and answer questions using a questionnaire about birthdays.

A new topic of parts of the body will be our focus. This will include descriptions using adjectives.

This half term we will learn how to name the members of our family. We will also listen to a story about Goldilocks in Spanish

We will revisit our greeting, numbers and colours.

Year 1 & 2:

We will extend our number up to 30 so that we can say the date & birthdays in detail in Spanish.

Learning about flags from Spanish speaking countries will help us to revise our colours.
