In Literacy, we will be studying books by famous authors. We will be developing the composition and effect of our writing; improving our use of punctuation and grammar and developing our vocabulary choices

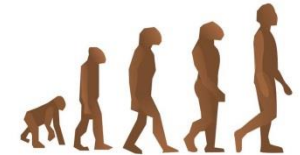


As mathematicians, we will continue to develop the mental strategies we use to calculate problems quickly. We will be developing our understanding of algebra, measure and ratio.

We will also be carrying out investigations, therefore, developing both our scientific knowledge and skills.

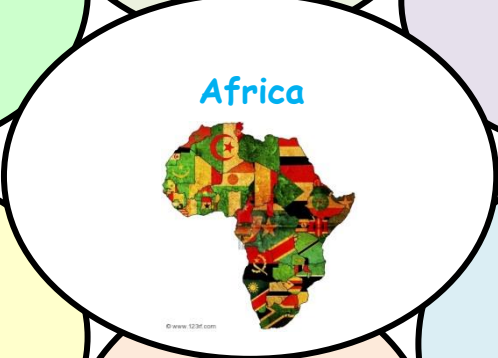
