Our topic this half term is 'Hot and Cold Environments'

Communication and Language

We will be continuing to maintain our attention and concentration during activities.
We will be learning to understand humour.
We will be responding to two-part instructions.
We will be extending our vocabulary and exploring the meaning and sound of new words.



Understanding the World

We will be looking closely at similarities and differences.
We will be looking at patterns and change.
We will be completing simple programmes on a computer.
We will be using ICT hardware to interact with computer software.

Literacy

We will be segmenting sounds in simple words and blending them together
We will be giving meaning to our marks as we draw, write and paint
We will be continuing to hear and say the initial sounds in words
We will be continuing to learn to write our name

Physical Development

We will be learning how to throw and catch a bean bag using an underarm throw. Once we become confident we will learn how to bounce and catch a ball with a partner. We will be eating a range of healthy food and understanding variety.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be building a repertoire of songs and dances.
We will be exploring different sounds and instruments.
We will be mixing colours and exploring what happens.
We will be creating simple representations of events, people and objects.

Mathematics

We will be recognising numerals and counting objects.
We will be using mathematical language for 3D and 2D shapes.
We will be finding one more and one less than a given number.

We will be initiating conversations.
We will be developing confidence to speak to others.
We will be understanding that our actions affect other people.
