Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you have been able to book an appointment to meet your child's class teacher and look at books at our parents' evening which is due to take place on Thursday 8th December. Sharing learning outcomes with children gives them a chance to feel proud of what they do in school and know that you value learning as much as they do. You can book an appointment online or through the school office.

Now that it is getting dark much earlier in the evening, please make sure that you have made arrangements to pick up your child on time if they attend an after school curriculum club or our after school care club. If your child is in Year 5 or 6 and you have given permission for them to walk home on their own, make sure that they know you are expecting them to walk straight home by the safest and most direct route, crossing the roads with care. Lots of jackets and bags have reflective strips and this will give some extra help and safety when negotiating the Hackney traffic. We are delighted that so many children arrive at school on scooters and bikes as this is an excellent way to get daily exercise. Our scooter and bike racks get full very quickly. Please help your child to show consideration to others by storing these safely and with care.

We have a number of end of term concerts and events approaching including sing-a-longs and for our Early Years children a traditional play. The dates for all seasonal events are displayed on gates, are on the school website and were sent home on the parent dates flier at the start of the half term. We had a high demand for pantomime tickets for Years 3 to 6 at the Hackney Empire and Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are being visited by a professional pantomime theatre company in December so that they do not miss out. Christmas Jumper and Christmas Dinner day will be taking place on the 9th December. Despite all the events, we will be ensuring children receive their full learning entitlement through until the end of term on the 16th December.

Greenpeace Visit

EYFS had the pleasure of receiving a visit from Green Peace to learn about their role in protecting our environment. The children in Reception learnt about how icebergs melting is affecting the lives of polar bears, whilst the children in Nursery learnt about recycling effectively by sorting different materials into their appropriate bins.



Mudchute Farm Visit

Year 1 had an amazing time at Mudchute Farm last week where they used their knowledge of animal categories to sort them into groups, and their knowledge of human and physical features to discuss their environment. They were most excited to feed the sheep at the end of their visit.



Science Workshop

Year 6 have been learning all about the circulatory system this half term. This week, they participated in a workshop with 'Hands on Science', where the had the opportunity to dissect a lamb's heart. The children were able to discuss what they knew already about the function of the heart and how it is vital to the circulatory system.







Teeth Workshop

Year 4 took part in a teeth workshop where they explored how to look after our teeth, different types of teeth and how to make a plaster mould of teeth. They carefully measured different substances and worked with their partners to create their models of teeth.



Making 3D Houses

This half term, Year 5 have been learning about 3D modelling using a programme called 'Sketchup'. They have designed their own houses using the different tools on the programme to create roofs, windows, doors and other features. They are looking forward to having some of their best models printed using a 3D printer.


