Children have been given new home reading diaries and reading books this week. Reading is an important part of wider learning. Daily practice supports fluency and understanding. All primary school children in Reception to Year 6 in state-funded schools in London will get free school meals for the 2023/24 school year. The Mayor of London, Sadiq Khan is providing the funding as an emergency cost of living support measure. The meals will help families with the spiralling cost of living. In addition, our school is also funding free school meals for all full time Nursery children.

At the end of last term, we were pleased to receive our Key Stage 2 results which again places the achievements of pupils at Orchard, Southwold and Hoxton Garden schools well above national averages. This is down to the hard work of pupils and teachers, but also very much due to the support that you give from home in ensuring that children read every night, learn times tables, complete homework tasks and come to school ready to learn.


