Dear Parents and Carers,

Mobile Farm

EYFS enjoyed a visit from the mobile farm this week. Special guests included chickens and guinea pigs. The children were kind, gentle and compassionate towards the animals. They also had the opportunity to learn about the animals' diets, discovering what chickens and guinea pigs like to eat.



Micro-Habitats

Year 2 had the opportunity to visit Hampstead Heath to carry out investigations on microhabitats. They got to explore the vast woodland and ponds, seeing the different species that live in each area. They even managed to find some newts!



Volcanic Eruptions

Year 6 have been making their own volcanic eruptions this week. They mixed carbonates and acids to create a solution. This solution had a chemical reaction which was rapid and vigorous and resulted in carbon dioxide being formed. This could be observed in the form of cascading bubbles. They added fluorescent paint and were able to see it glow!





Eco-Team Morning

The Eco-Team hosted a successful coffee morning which focused on encouraging environmental care. Parents and children learned tips on how to create a sustainable home environment, and they even reused milk and egg cartons to plant cress seeds in.



Water Safety

Hoxton Garden pupils enjoyed a water safety assembly delivered by the Canal River Trust Outreach. They learned to identify various hazards close to the canal and how to avoid them. They even thought of some life saving actions in case of an emergency!


Attendance
