Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you were able to meet with your child's class teacher at parents evening last week and enjoyed looking through your child's books. If you were not able to attend, please contact the school office or speak to the class teacher, so that we can arrange a new meeting time for you. If you did not collect your child's termly report, this will be posted to you. Each child's report contains targets and areas to work on in the coming term. Please help us to help your child by encouraging them to learn their times tables (or if younger counting in steps of 1,2,5 and 10), practise spellings and read at home either with you, or on their own. Children achieve so much more if they are encouraged to learn these key skills at home as well as at school.

This week we undertook our annual pupil survey which all children in Year 1 to 6 were asked to take part in. Children had the opportunity to share their opinions about learning, personal development, wellbeing and behaviour. We will be sharing the headlines of the survey in the new term in our newsletter as well as on our website, so watch this space!

Attendance at school continues to be a national focus, a Hackney focus and a focus for our schools. Central to raising standards in education and ensuring all pupils can fulfil their potential is the understanding that pupils need to attend school regularly to benefit from their education. Missing out on lessons leaves children vulnerable to falling behind. A big thank you to all parents who are supporting children to attend school every day and are punctual each morning. This has a positive impact on confidence, engagement in learning and progress. Top tips shared by parents to help children take responsibility for good timekeeping include giving children their own alarm clock, having a set morning routine and preparing things needed for the next day the night before.

Spring term ends today, Friday 4th April 2025. We have set holiday homework projects including research projects for the topics classes will be studying in the first half of the Summer term. Please encourage children to explore the themes they will be learning about and, of course, continue to encourage them to read, write and count every day. 
Attendance
