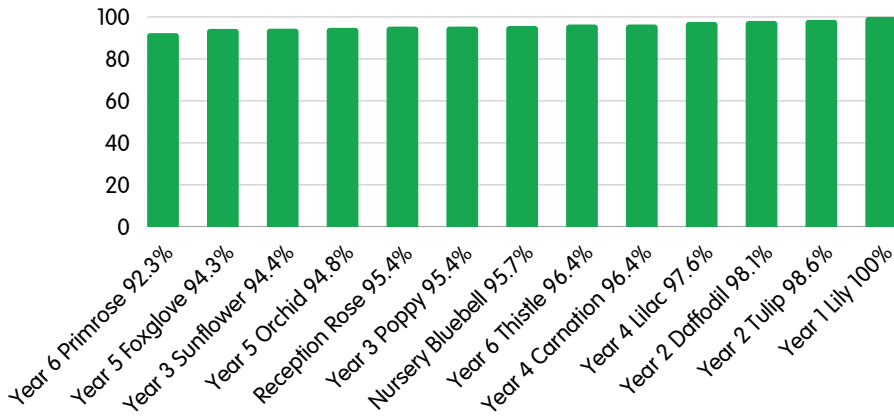
Attendance
